RESPONSIBILITIES OF CHILDREN'S SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHERS

Responsibilities of a teacher are to

- 1. **Guide** children to know God and His redemptive message in the Bible, Lead girls and boys to accept Christ when they are so convicted by the Holy Spirit.
 - Guide a group of children in Bible study giving guidance to individual Bible study activities.
 - Assist the department director in Bible study activities and fellowship activities.
 - Be able to counsel children concerning God and His redemptive plan.
- 2. **Promote,** encourage, and participate in in-reach, home-reach, and outreach activities, including evangelistic visitation and ministry.
 - Visit or contact absentees each week.
 - Provide current information to the department director concerning prayer concerns and needs.
- 3. **Cooperate** with other children's workers in discovering and cultivating prospects and their families and in cultivating members and their families.
 - Assist with maintaining an up-to-date department prospect file.
 - Encourage and participate in weekly evangelistic visitation efforts.
- 4. **Participate** in regularly scheduled weekly or monthly worker meetings.
 - Be prepared for weekly or monthly workers meetings by studying the unit Bible material and suggested teaching procedures.
 - Encourage other workers to participate in weekly or monthly workers meetings.
- 5. **Engage** in training and study activities to improve effectiveness in teaching, reaching, and evangelistic witnessing.
 - Assist department director in planning, doing, and evaluating the work of the department through use of the *Children's Sunday School Standard*.
- 6. **Attend** and support church worship services and the church programs and emphases.
 - Assist the department director in cooperating with other children's programs in the use of children's space, equipment, and materials used for Sunday School.
 - Attend worship services regularly.
