We introduce preschoolers to their heavenly Father through His Word, and encourage them to discover God's love in His creation. By the time a child is five years old, he will have learned the basic stories of creation, the Old Testament, and the life of Christ. Through a variety of Bible learning activities, children will learn the truth of God's Word at their level of comprehension.

• Grade-School Ministries—Our goal for the elementary child, grades 1 through 6, is both to have fun and be spiritually challenged. Through a systematic study of the Word of God, children are encouraged to explore "what God says," "what it means to me," 'and how it can be applied to my life." In fact, by the sixth grade, children will have overviewed the entire Bible six times. We strive for a well-rounded ministry of instruction, evangelism, discipleship, Bible memory, outreach events, missions, worship, sports activities, music, special events, and ministry opportunities.
